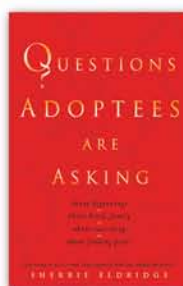
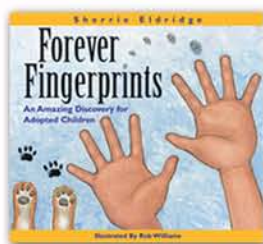
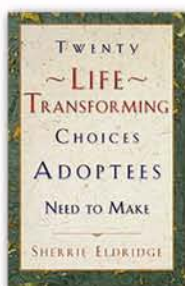

Currently, she is writing a sequel to the best-seller, titled *Twenty Things Adoptive Parents Need to Succeed* (Bantam Dell, 2009).

Sherrie has spoken around the world & in 22 states.

- **China:** spoke for government officials, university professors, and orphanage staff.
- **Thailand:** spoke to parents & orphanage staff.
- **Canada:** spoke in Montreal and will be featured in a video for adoptive parents being taped in Vancouver, BC., spring 2009.
- **USA Government:** In 2008 spoke to Senator Miller of Indiana about adoption reform. In 2009 will speak for American Adoption Congress.
